Something special fills the air at the beginning of the year. Enthusiasm and excitement abound. Whether you encounter high school student body officers on a


scavenger hunt in the district office or second graders excited to meet their new teacher, you can feel the positive energy students bring to the new school year.

### Cheyanne Ashton, Cyprus High


